### **Core Strategy and Ministry Overview**

- When we first meet three years ago I presented Paul's core ministry strategy as the model for how we were going to attempt to do things here at Grace Life Bible Church.
- What was his strategy?
  - He **evangelized** strategic cities to establish a beachhead of believers that could reach into the surrounding areas (Acts 15:36, 16:12, Acts 17, 18:10, 19:35).
  - He **edified** the new believes in sound doctrine.
  - He **established** the communities of believers into organized local churches.
  - He **enlisted** key men that could be trained to carry on the work and lead the churches in his absence (Acts 20:28, Tiuts 1:5).
  - He used the local churches as a base from which to **expand** the gospel into outlying communities.
- Paul needed fellowlaboures to partner with him in the ministry. In order to be successful every ministry needs people to share of their time, talents, and finances. Philemon 24, Colossians 4:11.

### **Goals for Year Four**

- Given the size of the assembly and the scope of the ministries we are already supporting the board feels it would irresponsible to take on a host of new ministries at this time. Rather we feel we need to strengthen and stabilize the ministries we are already running.

- We are moving out of the honeymoon phase of our church and the reality of doing the working of the ministry is settling in. Now more than ever we need to continue to strive together for the faith of the gospel and press toward the mark (Philippians 1:27, 3:14).
