To say, "Reconciliation and forgiveness of sins was made possible at the cross, but only given to those who have believed Paul's gospel" is NOT Paul's gospel! It is a perversion of it! Only an unbeliever in what took place/ what was accomplished by God 2000 years ago would argue that 2 Corinthians 5:19 isn't when Christ was made to be sin for us, died for our sins, was buried and was raised again the third day for our justification as a ransom FOR ALL.

Reconciliation took place 2000 years ago (Romans 5:10,18) when God was in Christ, reconciling the world unto himself, not imputing their (THE WORLD) trespasses unto them. **DENYING FORGIVENESS ON
THE CROSS IS NOT JUST A
DOCTRINE ISSUE...
IT'S ANOTHER GOSPEL!**

IT WAS GOD IN CHRIST

(the gospel of your salvation)

If one is not forgiven unless and until he believed the gospel of Christ as some wrongly preach, Paul would have worded Romans 1:16 to convey that. It would have said, "For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God UNTO FORGIVENESS to every one that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek." but that's not what it says! It says the gospel of Christ is the power of God UNTO SALVATION to every one that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek".

FORGIVENESS WAS A DONE DEAL BY THE CROSSWORK OF CHRIST IN OUR STEAD AND GOD RAISING HIM FROM THE DEAD VICTORIOUS!

What does that mean? It means they believed not the good news and because they didn't they perished. IT DOES NOT mean that Christ didn't die for their sins! He most certainly did! They just didn't believe it and therefore the faith of Jesus Christ and His finished work on the cross (even the righteousness of God) was not put to their account (not imputed to them).

If believing what the Bible says about reconciliation and the issue of sin/sins being settled by God through the cross work of Christ 2000 years ago makes me a "new reconciliationist" as some have coined us, so be it!
