## Introduction

- In the last lesson we looked at four primary reasons believers don't witness for Christ:
  - Spiritual Lethargy
  - o Believing the Enemy's Lies
  - Lack of Know-How
  - o Fear—is constant and cannot be eliminated, therefore it must be displaced by something else, something stronger. Fear can only be overcome through displacement.
- Formula for overcoming fear:
  - o F—FAITH
    - In the Message
    - In the Messenger
  - o E—EQUIPPING
  - o A—ACTION
  - o R—REASON—If you have a big enough reason you can do anything
- This morning I want to move into addressing lack of know-how and begin offering some equipping so that we can all be effective ambassadors.

## **Mastering the Three Critical Issues**

- Learn these three great issues word perfect! They are the bedrock of the gospel. Knowing them thoroughly develops reserve power in our presentation.
- Man's Problem:
  - o ALL MEN ARE SINNERS, AND SIN SEPRTES FROM GOD
  - o Key Verses—Romans 3:10, 23, Ecclesiastes 7:20
  - The essence of sin:
    - Demanding our own way: ME FRIST (autonomy)
    - Defying the will of God: Stay out of my life (rebellion)
    - Driven by selfishness to do the wrong thing (unrighteousness)
  - Bridge: Sin carries a fearful consequence
  - The penalty of sin is death
  - Key Verses: Romans 6:23, Ezekiel 18:4, Ephesians 2:1, Revelation 21:8
  - Death means separation:

- Physical death: Separation of soul and body.
- Spiritual death: Separation of my spirit for God's Spirit
- Second death: Separation forever from the presence of God in the Lake of Fire.
- o Bridge: That's the bad news—the good news is that Romans 6:23 has another part to it.

## • God's Solution:

## CALVARY IS GOD'S ONLY SOLUTION FOR MAN'S SIN

- We are not saved by our performance but by Christ's sacrifice. Men have so many false hopes which are rooted in performance.
- Calvary is God's only provision. The work of Christ cannot be mixed with religious rites and moral obligations.
- The saving work of Christ is finished. Because we do not await the outcome of any contingencies we can have peace with God today.
- o Jesus Christ died on Calvary to pay the penalty for man's sins
- o Key Verses: Romans 5:8, 4:24-25, 6:23b
- o Key Concept: Christ is our substitute and full payment for sin
- o Illustration: Book of sins placed on Christ, Free gift is already paid for, Hand them something and ask when and how did you receive that.
- o Bridge: How would you reach out and take the gift of eternal life?
- Our Responsibility: Exercising Saving Faith
  - CLAIMING BY PERSOANL CHOICE AND RELYING EXCLUSIVELY UPON CHRISTS WORK ON THE CROSS TO BE THE SUFFICENT PAYMENT FOR MY SIN!
  - o Choice: A person's will is involved. The gift of eternal life is available to anyone who will claim for his or herself.
  - Trust: Relying exclusively upon. Salvation is our as we recline in or sit down in the promise of God.
  - We must receive the gift of eternal life by exercising saving faith
  - o Key Verses: Romans 4:4-5, 4:20-21, Ephesians 2:8-9, Romans 10:17
- Key Concept: Personal choice and trust.
