The Son of God Became One Of The Sons Of Men

- The story of Christ's advent into the world centers around the miraculous conception of life within the Mary's womb.
- Luke 1:26-38—the Angel Gabriel announced to Mary that she was the give birth to the Son of God. The Child that Mary will conceive in her womb will be the fulfillment of Isaiah 9:6-7.
 - o shall be called the Son of the Highest,
 - o will be given the throne of his father David,
 - o will reign over the house of Jacob
 - o His kingdom will never end
- Luke 1:34-37—Gabriel explains to Mary who her baby can be the fulfillment of Isaiah 7:14 even though she has never known a man.
 - o The Child that will be conceived in her womb will be of the Holy Ghost.
 - o The power of the Highest shall overshadow thee
 - o The child that will be born will be the son of God.

- The conception and birth of Jesus Christ was a miraculous event the fulfilled Biblical prophecy.

"Life" in the Book of John

- The word "life" occurs 44 times in 38 verses in the book of John. It is a major theme of the book.
- John 1:1-4—Jesus Christ is explicitly said to be "life" in verse 4. As such Christ preexisted the beginning.
 - Micha 5:2—"whose goings forth have been from of old, from everlasting."
