Important Points About the But Now Period

- The Body of Christ is God's agency for the heavenly places.
- The operating system today is *Grace*.
- Salvation and blessing are provided to all people on an equal basis— "there is no difference."
- God's purpose is to exalt Jesus Christ as Head of the government in the heavenly places through the instrumentality of the body of Christ.

The Bible Without Paul?

- Without Paul's message, ministry and Apostleship the following things would be lost:
 - The Body of Christ (Eph. 3:3-6)
 - The Dispensation of Grace (Eph. 3:1-2)
 - The Gospel of Grace (Acts 20:24, I Cor. 15:3-4)
 - The Temporary Setting Aside of Israel (Rom. 11:11, 25)
 - The Rapture of the Church (I Cor. 15:51-53, I Thess. 4:13-18)
 - The "no difference between Jew and Gentiles" status (Rom. 10:11, Eph. 2:13-18)
 - The Reconciliation of the Heavenly Places and the Church's role in that process (Col. 1:16-20, Eph. 1:20-23)
- Colossians 1:25—without the mystery revealed to and through the Apostle Paul the word of God would be incomplete.
